

ONIX for Books codelists Issue 34

This is the consolidated list of agreed additions and updates for Issue 34 of the ONIX for Books codelists. These have been circulated for comment to the national groups and feedback received has been incorporated.

Following the end of 'twilight' support for ONIX 2.1-only codelists at the end of 2015, it does not generally include any additions for lists used *only* in 2.1, though 2.1 continues to benefit from updates to lists it shares with 3.0. However, there are minor clarifications to the notes associated with three codes in List 26.

Note that Issue 36 (January 2017) may be the last version of the codelists usable with ONIX 2.1. This timetable has been discussed by the ONIX International Steering Committee, but is not yet 'set in stone', so comments are invited – to graham@editeur.org. To be crystal clear, this does not mean ONIX 2.1 will be unusable after the beginning of 2017 – it means only that no further new codes will be added, even as a side-effect of adding them to ONIX 3.0. ONIX 2.1 would be 'frozen' with Issue 36 while ONIX 3.0 continues to receive quarterly codelist updates. This is part of the phased reduction of support for 2.1.

B2	Keywords (not for display)	For indexing and search purposes, MUST NOT be displayed. Use code B2 in preference to code 20 where it is important to show the keyword list is specifically NOT for display to purchasers</subjectheadingtext>

ZL does not cover disposable bags (eg in paper or plastic). It is intended for durable bags, typically textile.

List 166 – Supply date role (ONIX 3.0 only)

50	New supplier start date	First date on which the supplier specified in <newsupplier> will accept orders. Note the first date would typically be the day after the old supplier end date, but they may overlap if there is an agreement to forward any orders between old and new supplier for fulfillment</newsupplier>
51	Supplier end date	Last date on which the supplier specified in <supplier> will accept orders. New supplier should be specified where available. Note last date would typically be the day before the new supplier start date, but they may overlap if there is an agreement to forward any orders between old and new supplier for fulfillment</supplier>

List 167 – Price condition type (ONIX 3.0 only)

Code	Label	Note
10	Rental duration	The duration of the rental to which the price applies. Deprecated, use <priceconstraint> instead</priceconstraint>
12	Rental extension	Upgrade to longer rental duration. <priceconditionquantity> gives minimum prior rental duration, and <productidentifier> may be used if the prior rental used a different product identifier. Separate price constraint with time limited license duration (code 10 07) specifies the new combined rental duration</productidentifier></priceconditionquantity>

This deprecation arises from the introduction of <PriceConstraint> in ONIX 3.0.3, as a better way of limiting the term of a rental (where different rental durations are not given separate product identifiers).

List 175 – Product form detail (ONIX 3.0 only)

Code	Label	Note
B316	Swiss binding	Cover is attached to the book block along only one edge of the spine, allowing the cover to lay flat
B317	Notched binding	Refinement of perfect binding, with notches cut in the spine of the book block prior to glueing, to improve adhesion and durability

List 217 – Price identifier type (ONIX 3.0 only)

Code	Label	Note
06	Proprietary product price point identifier	Proprietary identifier uniquely identifies a specific combination of product, price amount and currency, independent of the price type
07	Proprietary product price type identifier	Proprietary identifier uniquely identifies a specific combination of product, price type, qualifier and any constraints and conditions, independent of the price amount and currency. A product with the same product price type identifier may carry differing price amounts, currencies at different points in time
